Incentive Grant & Service Scholarship Application



Incentive Grant: Give back and keep connected by performing service at FPCJ and community service during school breaks or throughout the year.

Service Scholarship: Give back by performing service at FPCJ and community service during school breaks or throughout the year, while earning and maintaining a high level of academic achievement.

DEADLINE to Apply:
JULY 31, 2022

FPCJ college students are encouraged to reach their highest potential in their studies and to help others along their journey.

Scholarships and Grants will be awarded to those students who embrace and achieve these efforts.

ELIGIBILITY & INSTRUCTIONS:**For Incentive Grant: §**

- ✚ Must be a member of FPCJ or Youth group participant (age 17–24 years)
- ✚ Must be a full-time undergraduate student at a 2-year or 4-year college or certified trade/technical school.
- ✚ Must perform at least 20 hours of church/community service⁽²⁾ per school year which must include at least 10 hours of service at FPCJ during school breaks or during the year (i.e. summer, between semesters for away students and anytime for commuter students) which can include assisting with Sunday school, soup kitchen, scholarship fundraising activities or assisting with any other ministry at FPCJ. You must write your intended commitment for your FPCJ service in your application for the upcoming school year plus recipients from previous year must also confirm their service performed at FPCJ during the previous school year, with sign off from a ministry leader at the Church. In addition for first time applicants, you must demonstrate that you have been active in the life of the church leading up to your application submission.
- ✚ Must provide copy of acceptance letter from school for entering freshman or transfer students. Continuing students must submit confirmation of registration per semester as proof of enrollment.
- ✚ Must participate in at least one FPCJ Scholarship Fundraiser event.

Scholarship: §§

- ✚ Must be a member of FPCJ or Youth group participant (age 17–24 years)
- ✚ Must be a full-time undergraduate student at a 2-year or 4-year college or certified trade/technical school with a minimum cumulative 2.75 GPA⁽¹⁾. Verification must come from a school document or transcript.
- ✚ **Submit a Personal Statement – 300 word minimum on one of the following topics:**
 - Personal challenge faced and how faith/spiritual guidance/prayer impacted
 - Education & Personal Goals: What's your plan for success in college? OR, Reflect on previous school year— still on track?
 - Address any major change of education/personal goals or new challenges faced which may have impacted the change
- ✚ Must perform at least 40 hours of church/community service⁽²⁾ per school year which must include at least 10 hours of service at FPCJ during school breaks or during the year (i.e. summer, between semesters for away students and anytime for commuter students). Your service at FPCJ can include assisting with Sunday school, soup kitchen, scholarship fundraising activities or assisting with any other FPCJ ministry. You must write your intended service commitment in your application for the upcoming school year plus recipients from previous year must confirm their service performed at FPCJ during the previous school year, with sign off from a ministry leader at the Church. In addition for first time applicants, you must demonstrate that you have been active in the life of the church leading up to your application submission.
- ✚ Must participate in at least one FPCJ Scholarship Fundraiser event.
- ✚ Must provide copy of acceptance letter from school for entering freshman or transfer students. Continuing students may submit confirmation of registration as proof of enrollment.

**** Note that if you do not meet the eligibility for the Service Scholarship you will automatically be considered for the Incentive Grant. ****

APPLICATION DATES:

- ✚ **Deadline for submitting application with ALL your supporting documentation is July 31, 2022. Applications will not be accepted after that date.** The next opportunity to apply will be in 2023 for the next school year.

AWARDS: Grant and Scholarship awards will be distributed in August 2022. Additional award for spring 2023 to be determined. **Remember to verify your spring semester enrollment** by submitting registration confirmation early January 2023.
